Member Organizations: Call to Action

Over the past few years, DivSeek International Network has successfully established as a global community facilitating open dissemination of information about plant genetic resources. With establishment of regional hubs, this has enabled us to extend and engage with members, hubs and stakeholders to help prioritise Strategic Plan Objectives amenable to funding. In many cases these objectives have generic impact (across crops and locations), and align with national and international strategic priorities. DivSeek has close interaction with key national and multi-national organizations such as the FAO International Treaty on Plant Genetic Resources for Food & Agriculture, the Crop Trust, and One CG, and is extending its range of active partnerships.

Following the pandemic, DivSeek was fortunate to obtain a no-cost extension to the initial establishment funds from Genome Prairie (Genome Canada) and the Global Institute of Food Security. This has enabled us to extend our communications and stakeholder reach.

However, we now face a precipitous end-of project at: June 30, 2023.





# Survey Overview and Demographics

• Late August 2022 to early December 2022

- Only 33 people completed the survey.
  - Most from Europe and North America + some from Africa, Asia, and Oceania.
  - Mostly researchers universities, gene banks, governments.
- ~50% indicated that they could respond on behalf of their organization.



# Survey – Interactions With DivSeek

• A large majority reported that they had direct interactions with DivSeek through Webinars, AGM's as well as working groups (WGs) and Hub meetings.

• Of these interactions, webinars were seen as the most useful, while WGs had a more mixed response.

 When asked about what DivSeek provides that respondents find valuable, the most common response was networking and the exchange of knowledge with others working in their field.



# Survey – Support for DivSeek and Interactions with Other Members

- Very few respondents currently support DivSeek. The most common support currently offered is providing staff time and resources for DivSeek work and events.
- ~50% indicated that their organization anticipates being able to support DivSeek in the future, mostly in the form of sharing time, work, and expertise.
- While a majority indicated that they have various interactions with other member-organizations, < 1/3 of these were directly attributable to DivSeek's work.
- Most commonly reported interactions were sharing of data and collaboration on peer-reviewed publications.

# Survey – Approval of Vision, Mission, Goals, and Performance

• Broad approval of DivSeek's vision, mission, and goals, though several respondents indicated that *limited funding* inhibits DivSeeks ability to meet its goals.

• DivSeek effective in increasing awareness about relevance of PGR and believe that the organization operates with openness and integrity.

 Respondents scored DivSeek more poorly when asked if DivSeek enables better access to, and use of, the information that supports their work




